## Frequently Asked Reporting Questions

### Why can't I see all of a student's Accelerated Reader data when I select "All Time" as a reporting option?

We know that users need to be able to quickly run reports to see a student's latest Accelerated Reader activity. Because of the volume of quizzes that students in a class may have, we will be limiting the amount of data accessible from Accelerated Reader reports to the current year plus two previous years. This will help us to ensure high performance and quick reporting in your site.

### What assignment types apply to Accelerated Reader?

- If students are reading books and taking Reading Practice, Vocabulary Practice, or Literacy Skills Quizzes, you will find that data by selecting the application **Accelerated Reader**.
- If students are reading Nonfiction Articles, you will need to select **Read and Quiz Assignment**. You will find that data by selected the application Accelerated Reader and then **Read and Quiz Assignment**.
